

Amendment to TRANSIENT MERCHANT ORDINANCE

RESOLUTION 49/91

TOWN OF MARCY ORDINANCE #2 of 1984 which regulates transient merchants and peddlers who conduct business in the Town of Marcy shall be amended to provide the following:

Section 3(i) exemptions - There shall be added to the exemption provisions of this Ordinance the following Paragraph Numbered 5:

The Town of Marcy Town Board upon receipt of a written application may consider the granting of a special permit to any person who may be considered a transient merchant or peddler to conduct business within the Town of Marcy and relieve said persons from one or all of the requirements of said Ordinance upon satisfactory receipt of an appropriate application for license and such other documentation or instruments as may be required by the Board which shall satisfy the Board's concerns with regard to consumer protection of prospective purchasers, and assurance that the granting of a special permit will not unduly interfere with ongoing businesses being conducted within the Town of Marcy.

The application and documentation shall be reviewed by the Marcy Town Counsel who shall make a recommendation to the Town Board with regard to the application and its compliance with this section.

EFFECTIVE DATE - Amendment shall take effect immediately.
